The Pollution Research Group (PRG) in the School of Engineering is an externally-funded team of professional researchers working on multidisciplinary research projects in the urban and industrial water and sanitation sector.

PRG is part of a worldwide network of sanitation practitioners working in the field of faecal sludge management. PRG has been awarded a grant from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation to produce a book on the standardization of methods for faecal sludge management.

The project requires a full-time assistant editor with a chemistry background to work with the international project team to produce the book. The successful candidate will report to the PRG project leader and engineer, Dr Konstantina Velkushanova. The position is based on the Howard College campus of UKZN.
